Directions & Parking





Directions

The National Water Sports Centre, Holme Pierrepont is south east of Nottingham City Centre on Adbolton Lane, off Regatta Way. Access is via the A6011 (Radcliffe Road) just off the A52, and is well signposted as you approach. The address is: National Water Sports Centre, Adbolton Lane, Holme Pierrepont, Nottingham NG12 2LU.

Sat-Nav users are advised to use the name 'National Water Sports Centre' rather than the postcode, as some devices will direct you to Colwick Race Course as opposed to the Centre.

From the South:

Leave the MI at Junction 21A, signposted Leicester and Newark (immediately after Leicester Forest East Services). Stay on the A46 in the direction of Newark for I9 miles. Exit the A46 onto the A606, to Nottingham, and stay on the A606 for 5 miles. Take the fourth exit from the roundabout onto the A52 Nottingham Ring Road, signposted Grantham. Stay on the A52 for almost 3 miles. Turn left at the roundabout onto the A6011, signposted Nottingham. Keep to the right-hand lane through then lights and turn right into Regatta Way. Follow Regatta Way onto Adbolton Lane to NWSC.

From the North:


Leave the MI at Junction 24, and take the A453 towards Nottingham. After 8 miles, take the A52 Nottingham Ring Road, signposted Grantham. After 5 miles, turn left at the roundabout onto the A6011, signposted Nottingham. Keep to the righthand lane through then lights and turn right into Regatta Way. Follow Regatta Way onto Adbolton Lane to NWSC.

From the West:

Junction 24 of the MI is still the best route: follow directions as from the North.

From the East:

Approach Nottingham on the A52 (from Grantham): the NWSC is 2 miles east of the city.



Car parking

There are four car parks for competitors, coaches and spectators. The Grass Bank (weather permitting), Car Park A and the Family Fun Car Park are located on the north side of the course; Car Park B is on the south side of the course. These are the only car parks that competitors, coaches and spectators may use; the Main (Officials') Car Park must **not** be used. Vehicle parking is administered by Holme Pierrepont Leisure Trust and charged at £5 per vehicle per day. Please do not park on any of roads surrounding NWSC with double yellow lines as parking wardens are often present on event days.

Trailers and towing vehicles


The designated parking sites for trailers and towing vehicles are shown on the map below. Trailer Park I is located next to the boathouse and Registration Office. Where Adbolton Lane forks, take the right-hand fork and then take the first left into Trailer Park I. The entrance to Trailer Park 3 is just after Trailer Park I but on the opposite side of the road. Please note that Trailer Park 3 will be opened by NWSC an overflow park only. Trailer

Park 2 is on the Grass Bank on the north side of the course; take the left-hand fork on Adbolton Lane. The gates are opened at 06:30 and closed at 22:00 daily.

Towing vehicles (i.e. vehicles towing a trailer carrying one or more boats to the Regatta, or vehicles carrying boats on the roof rack) are not charged for parking. This excludes vehicles transporting only blades, riggers, parts, equipment, accessories and/or personnel.

Trailers and towing vehicles may be brought through to the Finish Area for unloading on Friday, Saturday and Sunday morning until 90 minutes before the first race of the day and from after the last race of the day. Entry and exit is only permitted through the boathouse gate (via Trailer Park I). Towing vehicles and trailers must not drive further than the halfgate by the 'new boathouse' / Finish Tower (see map below).

Boats should be stored on your trailer or on the racks in the Finish Area. Please remember to tie down your boat to prevent it from being blown off the racks. Certain racks are reserved for medal winners or specific boat types. These will be clearly marked and must only be used by those boats indicated.



Admission prices

Competitors and their coaches are permitted access to the site without payment on production of a competitor's badge. These badges will be available for collection at Registration on Friday and Saturday morning, and you will be allowed to access the site to collect them.

Spectators will need to purchase an admission badge from the gate stewards on arrival. These are priced at £5 per adult per day and free for those under 18 years of age.

Gazebos

Gazebos, marquees, tents and similar structures may only be pitched on the Grass Bank on the designated pitches. As at 9th July 2016 all the pitches have been booked. Disabled parking

Parking close to the Lakeside (Main Centre) Building is available for registered Blue Badge holders. Head for the Main Gate (Officials' Car Park) where you will be directed by the stewards. Ensure you bring your badge with you.
